Recently, I was called to assist the Police in a small, rural town over two hours from our location in Stratham. As the Cruelty Investigator for the New Hampshire SPCA, I am called out regularly to help police departments contend with situations of cruelty, neglect, or like in this case, the hoarding of animals.

Our combined investigation confirmed that the owners were

overwhelmed by the sheer number of animals that they had, and as a result, the animals were not receiving proper care. The Police Chief spoke to the owners and convinced them to decrease the number of animals that they were caring for to a smaller number that they could properly care for. He also told them that there would be four charges of animal cruelty for the neglect, one charge for each species that they had been keeping, rabbits,

guinea pigs, dogs, and horses.

Voluntarily surrendered to the NHSPCA were 27 rabbits, 15 guinea pigs, two dogs with a total of 11 puppies and three horses. Because the owners voluntarily surrendered them, the animals were free to quickly receive proper medical treatment, time to recover and then be placed for adoption to forever

The horses needed veterinary and hoof care right away. The white horse was severely underweight. Her eyes looked hollow and so deeply sad when she first arrived. She would need a special re-feeding schedule to help her put weight back on slowly and safely. Molly, the brown horse, had a problem with her front feet caused by a birth defect that had never been treated. She walked on the

tips of her hooves. and tripped and staggered every few steps. She would require surgery to help her overcome this Continued on Page 13...

NHSPCA Community Wellness

It's a cool and sunny Thursday in March when we arrive at the Community Recreation Center at Gosling Meadows in Portsmouth, NH. The five of us, staff from the NHSPCA medical team led by Dr. Stephen Gentilella, pile out of

the NHSPCA van and are greeted by Tammy Joslyn and Grace Farnan from the Portsmouth Housing Authority. We're unsure of what to expect on the first of our grant and donor funded Community clinics for Wellness dogs and cats, but we quickly settle in and get

ready to greet our first clients.

An option for low cost vaccinations and medical care for senior and low income residents in the Seacoast area is a need the NHSPCA has been aware of for many years. Now with generous funding from Maddie's Fund, The Fuller Foundation, and donors who gave to the Special Fund at last year's Annual Auction we are able to get this program underway.

Riann Goodacre, Manager of Animal

Care and I, meet with our first client, whom I'll call "Donna". Donna has a beautiful and affectionate cat, however, she has been unable to get her to the vet recently because she doesn't drive anymore. It was obvious to me the deepness of the love she has for her cat and her desire to provide the best for her. Since Donna doesn't have a car, she walked to the

Recreation Center, cat carrier in hand, to make sure she was first in line to meet with the vet. For a small fee of \$10 our medical team provided a physical exam, vaccinations, deworming, flea/ preventative, tick

Dr. Gentilella determined that his eye was too far damaged to repair and needed to be removed immediately. During his recovery his cowering stopped. His body relaxed and his tail




Maybe it's a sign of the times: the farm program has taken in more animals during the first six months of 2017 than any year in recent memory. Of the 84 animals that have arrived, 24 are horses that have been surrendered by their owners.


Why do people give up their horses? There are as many answers as there are horses. It's a difficult decision for any owner, and most want to do the right thing. Sometimes the right thing is surrender. Mist and Cody arrived because their owner had retired and couldn't take care of them; mucking stalls and hauling water buckets became too difficult, and he now faced a fixed income with a tight budget. Cody, a handsome bay Standardbred could still enjoy light trail rides. Mist is a 21-year-old Mustang who needs to live outdoors full-time in a herd, with minimal human interaction. Bucky, a 30-yearold palomino, was initially rescued by someone who then fell on hard times and couldn't provide enough hay and grain, or proper shelter. When

Bucky arrived at the NHSPCA, his ribs protruded and his hip bones stuck out. But he hadn't given up on humans. Bucky now shares a pasture here with Cody and Mist. He nickers whenever he sees a human approach (preferably carrying a feed bucket and an armload of hay). Morgan mare Lilly and her yearling Justina came to the shelter last year because their owner died in a tragic accident; and his fiancée could not care for the horses by herself. Justina recently moved to her adoptive farm. Lilly, a lovely bay with a lively personality, has received some additional training off-site and is still waiting for her forever home.

Each of these horses—along with all the other horses in the farm program—deserves a forever home. Their owners believed this too, which is why they chose to surrender their equine companions to the NHSPCA. We will find the right match for them. Meanwhile, they need plenty of hay. 2017 Volunteer Recognition

It's hard to believe that 2017 is half over. Each month, new volunteers sign up for orientations and training (most of which is done by mentor volunteers) so there is a steady complement of people helping in the Adoption Center to care for the cats and small animals, walk dogs, and work in the barns and paddocks. In the first half of 2017, nearly 500 individuals donated over 18,000 hours of their time to support the NHSPCA.

While the majority of volunteers help with direct animal care, there are many others who helped to sustain the agency in other ways. For example, our volunteers were out in the community, representing the agency. Among the many events and activities NHSPCA volunteers helped with in the past six months were our major events such as the Doggie Paddle Plunge and Paws Walk. Besides these large events, our Community Outreach and off-site adoption events were supported by volunteers who helped with informational and fundraising events held at local restaurants, businesses and farmers markets. By participating in activities outside the shelter, volunteers have many opportunities to educate and inform the public about the NHSPCA's mission and goals. Volunteers can be ambassadors for the agency, and a single encounter with a sympathetic person could lead to a donation of money or pet food, an adoption, or a new volunteer.

In our Development & Marketing department, volunteers performed a variety of tasks that keep our mission going and growing. From writing thank you notes and making thank you calls to donors, to preparing envelopes and postcards for mailings, to organizing merchandise, volunteers are often willing to come in to help, sometimes on very short notice. Volunteers also help with Humane Education programs, providing children and youth opportunities to learn about animal welfare. In our Field Services department, volunteers helped with transports of animals from overcrowded shelters in other states.

When help is needed with maintenance or grounds-keeping projects, volunteers are always willing to lend a hand. We have also had a team of industrious volunteers performing grounds keeping duties--weeding our flower beds and pruning shrubs and trees both at the shelter and at our Rolling Meadows pet cemetery. Special thanks go to volunteers who come to the shelter just to help with laundry or to sort and store the many donations that arrive at the shelter.

The NHSPCA is grateful to local

companies that support community service by allowing their employees to come to the shelter for a few hours and sometimes a full day of volunteering. Comcast, Liberty Mutual and John Hancock are just three businesses to provide a "Day of Caring" to make the agency look its best by raking, mulching, cleaning and painting, or to help with events.

We are very fortunate that there are so many people who come to the shelter looking for that special animal companion to share their homes and their lives. Until these animals go to their "forever home," NHSPCA volunteers provide the care and compassion the animals need and deserve. NHSPCA volunteers work hard, but they are rewarded daily by wagging tails and contented purrs, and that's what makes our volunteers continue to come day after day, week after week, month after month, year after year. In 2017, NHSPCA volunteers will continue to demonstrate their passion for the animals with tender hearts and gentle hands. We couldn't do what we do without our dedicated volunteers, and we can never thank them enough for their care and compassion.





UPDATE: YOU DID IT! Your advocacy on behalf of FIV/FeLV cats helped win the fight. The exemption passed with the budget!




New Hampshire was previously one of only two states that did not allow cats with FeLV (Feline Leukemia Virus) and FIV (Feline Immunodeficiency Virus), two diseases which are not contagious to humans, to be responsibly adopted from the state's animal shelters in the state. In late May, an exemption for cats who test positive for FeLV/FIV to be placed in loving, responsible homes was removed from the state budget. We urged you to take immediate action to help change the fate for these New Hampshire cats. We asked

you to help us fight to get it back into the budget before the close of the legislative session—and you did it! The NH legislature passed the state budget and included the exemption for cats who test positive for FeLV/FIV! This is ONLY because of focused advocacy, phone calls and emails during the committee of conference process made by animal advocates like you! Thanks to your advocacy, euthanasia or long-term housing will no longer be the fate for these New Hampshire cats. Thank you!



condition and hopefully begin walking properly for the first time.

The rabbits suffered with ear mites. Some had problems with their limbs while others showed signs of old wounds and eye problems. The guinea pigs appeared to be in better shape with the exception of one that had an untreated open wound that also required medical intervention.

The owners plead guilty to charges of animal cruelty in District Court. In addition, they are now required to allow the police chief to conduct unannounced inspections to ensure nothing like this ever happens again.

The rabbits, guinea pigs, dogs and horses are all on the road to recovery through the efforts of our adoption staff and veterinarians. Some have even already been adopted to wonderful families.

It is a great feeling to know the NHSPCA is here to help animals overcome neglect or abuse and have a second chance. Afterall, we've been doing it since 1872.



We didn't have the copacity in the Adoption Center to house 27 rabbits and 15 guinea pigs, so we made our confrence room into a safe place for them for months.

cleaning and a nail trim. Residents also have access to dog and cat food that we provide that day.

The smile and relief on Donna's face was memorable. Knowing that her beloved pet was healthy gave her a sense of relief. I helped her get her cat settled back into the carrier and we had a chance to have a short talk. Donna is retired and lives alone, so her cat is her companion and friend. She took great pride in telling me of her silly antics and how she loved her cozy bed and toys. It was that kind of connection that is making these clinics so worthwhile.

Then there was Evelyn and her 17 yr. old cat Abby from Exeter. Evelyn moved into Exeter Senior housing after being diagnosed in 2014 with Parkinson's. She had lived in a large condo

in Exeter but decided that the number of stairs and the upkeep would be too much as her disease progressed. Although Evelyn has a primary vet that she brings Abby to she was very glad that the NHSPCA was able to provide this clinic. "Economics is a major issue especially being a retired single person on a fixed income", Evelyn states. In addition, she very much appreciated Dr. Gentilella and his assistant, Colleen O'Keefe being so professional and

compassionate. "He really took his time and made Abby feel comfortable. I never felt rushed and they answered all my questions."

So far this year, the NHSPCA Community Wellness Program has held five clinics throughout Portsmouth in conjunction with the Portsmouth Housing Authority and in Exeter with Exeter Housing. It's been a learning curve for all involved as we streamline the check in and registration process, packing and ordering of medical supplies and medications and coordinating venues and locations.

This fall the NHSPCA plans to continue more Wellness Clinics that will include low income and senior housing in Newmarket, Portsmouth and other Seacoast communities.








